



We have quite a few things that could help your patrons with their genealogy research. In general, we have newspapers from all 75 counties on microfilm, as well as records from all of the courthouses, all though coverage and date ranges vary by county. We also have a large collection of published local histories and family histories, church records, funeral home records, military records and various government documents.

Our research room is open to the public right now, by appointment only. We schedule appointments Monday through Friday, and select Saturdays, from 9:00 – 12:00 and 1:00 – 4:00. Patrons can also use that same email address to send in remote research requests, however, we are limited in how much research we can perform for a patron and it can take several weeks to get full responses back due to the volume of requests we receive and our small staff.
